JRE to Change Its Trade/Company Name

Japan Renewable Energy Corporation (“JRE”) hereby announces that on April 1, 2024 it will change its trade/company name to ENEOS Renewable Energy Corporation.

Since its founding in August 2012, JRE has sought to expand the use of renewable forms of energy, guided by its mission of changing the world with renewable energy. Following JRE’s incorporation as a subsidiary of ENEOS Corporation in January 2022 and the integration of the renewable energy business within the ENEOS Group in April 2023, JRE has grown into one of Japan’s leading renewable energy companies. The capacity of its power plants in operation and under construction currently exceeds 1.2 million kW.

A change in the ENEOS Group’s management structure in April 2024 will result in JRE becoming a principal operating company of the ENEOS Group and a directly owned subsidiary of ENEOS Holdings, Inc. Under the new company name, JRE will continue its existing efforts to expand the use of renewable energy and contribute to the creation of a decarbonized society, alongside striving to increase the corporate value of the ENEOS Group as a company that plays a key role within the Group.
