ERE Enters Corporate PPA with Amazon

ENEOS Renewable Energy Corporation (headquarters: Minato Ward, Tokyo; President, CEO, and Representative Director: Kazuhiro Takeuchi; hereinafter "ERE") entered into a corporate PPA^{*1} (hereinafter "PPA") with Amazon to provide renewable energy from a 9.5 megawatt (MW) solar power plant in Japan.

ERE will start operation of Kudamatsu Fourth Mega Solar Power Plant, which is now under construction in Kudamatsu City, Yamaguchi, by autumn 2025, and supply an estimated 20,000 MWh of renewable energy per year (equivalent to the amount of electricity consumed by 4,800 ordinary households per year*2) to Amazon.

Having enabled 20 solar projects in Japan, Amazon is now the largest corporate purchaser of renewable energy in the country, according to data from Bloomberg New Energy Finance.

ERE will continue to contribute to finding solutions to reduce companies' CO2 emissions, spreading scaling renewable energy, progressing towards decarbonized society, and driving positive community impact through renewable energy generation projects.
